Flagler County. This should be a concern and on the providers minds when seeing patients in their practices.

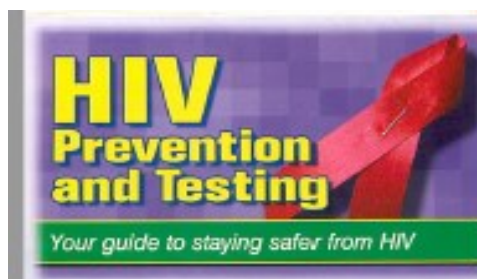
### **A diagnosis of UTI may be a STI...**

## HIV Treatment - Ryan White

and ADAP services available at DOH Flagler. Our clinic is in its 3rd year, under the care of Stephen Bickel, MD. We have provided care and medication assistance for over 50 people. Clients come from several counties in our area. We provide test and treat for newly diagnosed HIV infections. Our staff also provide PreP for those at highest risk for HIV infection.



## TB is still out there and curable.

We provide Direct Observation Therapy (DOT) which is standard practice for all active TB cases. TB and LTBI treatment can be facilitated through DOH Flagler by calling 386-437-7350 x 7088.



## MOSQUITOS are coming back!

They carry many illnesses that can effect the health of our residents in Flagler Co. Flagler has sentinel BIRDS that provide information on certain illnesses circulating in our area. DOH get reports weekly from spring till end of fall. Testing is done at an off site lab that target EEE, WNV, and SLE. Neuroinvasive diseases such as aseptic meningitis, encephalitis, or acute flaccid paralysis (AFP). Drain and Cover is the message you will hear us say this season.
